



2012 DISTRICT 10 4-H PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

Do you like taking pictures? Would you like to have your pictures on display for everyone to see and enjoy? The District 10 Photography contest is open to all Bandera County 4-H members.

Photo Classes & Divisions:

1. **Photos must have been taken by 4-H members between May 1, 2011 and time of entry.**
2. **Photography divisions, classes and descriptions are shown on the reverse side of this flyer.** These are the State Photography Rules which will be used for judging.
3. ***NEW* CREATIVE DISPLAY DIVISION**—color or black and white photos may be used. Exhibit will consist of one page, any size up to 12" x 12" paper, with pictures and embellishments. Page must be in a page protector. All types of media can be used.
4. Each 4-H member **may enter up to three (3) photos** in the District Contest. **Photos DO NOT have to be in different categories (i.e. 4-H'er may enter 3 animals-wildlife).** In addition to the 3 photos, a 4-H member **may enter one item in the Creative Display category.**
4. **Theme for the 2012 Contest is "Trains".**

Photo Size & Types:

Must be mounted on mat board or foam board cut the same size as the photo. Double sided tape, glue or rubber cement is not allowed for mounting purposes. **Photos must be 8 " x 10" in size.**

Photo Labeling

Photos must have the registration form label affixed to the back of the photo. Please be sure to tape or glue them securely.

Photo Deadline:

1. **The deadline to register and bring photos to the Bandera County Extension Office is March 7th by 5pm.**

How Do I Register?

1. From our website, <http://bandera-tx.tamu.edu>, select the "4-H Connect" link
2. At your member page, go to "Event Registrations"
3. Select member name and then "District 10 Photography Contest"
4. Follow the pages to enter your 3 photos.
5. For payment select "county/club check"
6. The Bandera 4-H County Council will pay the contest fee for the district contest.
7. Bring photo(s) to Extension Office by Wednesday, March 7th

Judging of Photos:

1. Photos will be on display at the District Roundup/Senior Fashion Show, April 21, 2012 at Comfort High School.
2. Photo contest results will be posted at the Bandera County website, at <http://bandera-tx.tamu.edu>, once they become available. From the Bandera County website, select "Publications" from the menu and then "4-H Project Resources. We will send a county wide email and post on the Bandera County 4-H Facebook page results are in. Photos and ribbons will be available for pick up at the Extension Office after April 25th.
