UPDATES FOR DISTRICT 10 4-H HORSE JUDGING:

NEW for 2024! The District 10 4-H Horse Judging contest will be hosted at the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo (HLSR) this year. In order to correctly register for this contest, all 4-H members must:

1. Submit entries/fees for the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo via JudgingCard.com. **Please contact the local County Office to correctly submit entries by the specified County deadline.**
2. Register all contestants/teams on 4HOnline by the District February 6th deadline in order to compete in the District 10 4-H Horse Judging qualifier.

MEMBERSHIP & AGE DIVISIONS

Participants must be 4-H members currently enrolled on 4HOnline and belong to a Texas 4-H Youth Development County program.

There are three age divisions for competition as outlined below. 4-H members' division is determined by their grade level by Aug. 31, 2023.

- Junior: 3rd (and 8 yrs. old) - 5th
- Intermediate: Grades 6th - 8th
- Senior: Grades 9th - 12th (and passed 18 yrs. old)

Note: Juniors may move up to the Intermediate age division when participating on an intermediate team. Intermediates/Seniors may NOT move up or down to a different age division. Additionally, H.L.S.R. Teams are designated by age. Therefore, their team designations may differ from 4-H. However, District 10 4-H Awards will be based on grade level like any other 4-H contest.

A few things to note....

- **Collegiate Scholarships will NOT be given out in 2024.**
- **URGENT - Information regarding FAFSA & Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship Applications:** FAFSA has rolled out a new form to be used for 2024-2025. FAFSA had a soft launch the last couple of weeks, but it is now fully functioning and the Texas 4-H Foundation will be moving forward with the following updated requirements:
 - **Applicants must complete a 2024-2025 FAFSA Application by January 31st** to be eligible for consideration for a Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship.
 - In the FAFSA section in the Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship application, applicants will input a "0" for the EFC box.
 - In the FAFSA upload spot, applicants will upload a screenshot of their FAFSA account dashboard that shows their form is in review, submission date, and name of applicant. (Ex: [HERE](#); You can take this with a phone, snipping tool, print screen, etc. to attach to the application. This screenshot can be from the parent dashboard or the applicant dashboard.)
 - If applicants receive their report back from FAFSA, input the report in the appropriate spots.
 - If applicants have not received their FAFSA report back by the February 15th deadline, they need to follow the instructions above using their FAFSA submission confirmation.
 - **The Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship DEADLINE is still February 15th.** There **WILL NOT** be an extension on the deadline.
 - Once applicants receive their official FAFSA report back (after February 15th), they will submit it using this link: <https://fs23.formsite.com/YVsLnb/junaan8zju/index> **The deadline to submit your FAFSA report through this link is March 31st.**

2024 TEXAS 4-H DOG SHOW T-SHIRT CONTEST

Entry Submission Rules & Guidelines:

- Must be a 4-H member enrolled in 4-H Online (single entry submission)
- Can use two ink colors in addition to the color of the shirt. Example: if the design calls for red, white and blue, one of those colors should be the color of the shirt. Do not select white as the shirt color choice.
- The design should fit on the front side of the t-shirt (12 inch design maximum)
- Be creative and develop an original design.
- Do not use copyrighted images.
- Simple designs are more effective and easier to screen print. Designs may have to be modified slightly to include the proper clover logo and to show up better.
- Entries should be uploaded at the link below or scan code
- Must be JPEG or PNG format
- Entries must be submitted using the QR code or via the link below

- A 4-H member cannot enter all (3) photos in the same category. The (3) photos must be entered in three different categories.
- If a 4-Her submits more than 3 photos, the registration will be returned and must be corrected by Tuesday - February 27, 2024 in order to be eligible for judging.

- **2024 Summer Camp Schedule:** [County Camp, Prime Time & Horizons Schedule](#)
- **Refashion Retreat (FLYER):** It's time to let your creative juices flow at 4-H Refashion Retreat! The event will be held **March 1-3, 2024**, at the Texas 4-H Center in Brownwood. Youth registration is \$170 and must have an adult chaperone accompanying them. Chaperone registration is free. Space is limited to 24 youth.
- **4-H Shooting Sports Coach Training (LETTER)** – Texas 4-H Shooting Sports Coach Training will take place on **March 8-9, 2024**. Disciplines TENTATIVELY offered are: Rifle, Archery, Shotgun, Pistol, Western Heritage. If a discipline is cancelled, registered attendees will be refunded or allowed to select a different discipline.
